

Excerpts of Dato' Chew's Speech at The Recent Graduation Ceremony of Monash University Sunway Campus



Dear Graduates,

Congratulations on obtaining your degrees. This graduation ceremony is a very important day not only for you, but also for your dear families as your loved ones have probably made sacrifices to help you achieve this milestone today. You are very special as you have received Monash degrees while studying in your home country. You have the best of both worlds as during my days you could not do a foreign degree without leaving home. In fact, getting a degree itself was a tall order. Let me tell you what it was like during my time.

I grew up in a small town called Mentakab, in Pahang, I am the third child and the eldest son in a family of five children. When I was seven, my father left us. Due to our tight financial situation, my siblings and I had to work to pay for our school fees from primary school onwards. After completing my O Levels, there was no school near my home that conducts A-Levels education. I only had the option of moving to Kuantan or KL but of course I could not afford that.

50 I joined Technical Teachers' Training College in KL, where my net monthly allowance was RM28, of which I sent RM25 home to help my family. When I started teaching, my monthly salary was RM370 a month, of which I sent RM180 to my two brothers who were studying A-Levels.

Our family was lucky as my brothers obtained scholarships to go to Universiti Malaya (formerly MU). One brother received a State Government Scholarship for science and the other received Colgate Palmolive Scholarship to study engineering. Through self-study, I also passed my A Levels a year after my youngest brother entered MU. Later, I joined my brothers in MU. The three of us shared the scholarship money which was intended for two. Never in her wildest dream did my mother ever thought all three of her sons would go to University. I learnt a few lessons along the way, the most important of which: In life we are all dealt with a different hand of cards. Often we cannot change these cards but what we can do is to make the best use of the cards we have.

Education is one of the greatest contributions to the progress and development of mankind. However, formal education cannot provide you with all the knowledge. It is important we know where the limits of formal education is so that we can complement our education with knowledge from other sources.

There are many great men who did not receive good formal education. For instance, Li Ka Shing whose business empire spreads across the globe, who only has a secondary school education. In Malaysia, the late Lim Goh Tong had very little formal education, yet he built a very successful business. Bill Gates, Michael Dell and Steve Jobs are all university drop outs, but we all know that they are legends in the business world. They received education but just not through formal channels.

Dear Graduates.

As you embark on a new journey after graduating, you may soon discover that very little of what you learned in the university is directly applicable to your work. However, your university education should enable you to learn and adapt quickly into the new environment. So you will probably learn how to do your job well very quickly with minimal guidance. More importantly you must remember to never stop learning and investing your time to improve yourselves. We, humans are the appreciating assets; the longer we work the more valuable we become because we improve over time, unlike other assets that depreciate over time. In fact, if our acquisition of new knowledge and skills is slower than the rate which knowledge and skills become obsolete, then we would start to depreciate. Learning is a life-long process, thus keep learning!


Sunway Medical Centre (SunMed) recently launched its Clinical Research Centre (CRC), a significant day officiated by Datuk Razman Hashim, Deputy Chairman of the Sunway Group. The development of the CRC is in line with the Healthcare NKEA for clinical trials in Malaysia and also SunMed's aspiration to become a world-class teaching hospital.

"The Clinical Research Centre aims to contribute significantly to the health and research industry by promoting excellence in clinical researches conducted here in Sunway Medical Centre.

As SunMed aspires to be a world-class teaching hospital, we are working towards becoming the best candidate to provide leading medical education," said Dr Chong, CEO Sunway Medical Centre.

The CRC was built during the major expansion of SunMed over the past three years. In mid-2009, SunMed signed a Memorandum of Agreement with the Jeffrey Cheah School of Medicine & Health Sciences and Monash University Sunway Campus, to collaborate in education and research. The development of

the CRC provides in-house capability to attract and manage clinical trials as well as to collaborate with the academicians of the Jeffrey Cheah School of Medicine in medical research.

The CRC was also launched in response to the demand or evidence-based clinical research in the hospital. The CRC seeks to promote ethical and reliable clinical research based on the international and local Good Clinical Practice (GCP) standards. In early 2010, SunMed set up the Sunway Medical Centre Independent Research Ethics Committee (SREC) with the primary purpose of ensuring the protection of the rights, safety and well being of human participants in research with special attention given to research involving use of genetic testing. It is also to ensure that all research is carried out in accordance with the International Conference of Harmonisation (ICH) and Malaysian Guideline for Good Clinical Practice (GCP). Apart from research projects activity, the CRC also assists in documenting and tracking progress of the clinical studies being conducted.

CRC is dedicated primarily towards coordinating all studies performed at Sunway Medical Centre covering research on pharmaceuticals, medical devices, medical records and biological samples, trials performed in Malaysia. The function as part of the no clinical research centres university hospitals, private targets of increasing the medical records and biological samples, trials performed in Malaysia.

epidemiological, social and psychological investigations.

Other CRC services include:

- Conduct feasibility studies for Pharmaceutical Companies;
- Manages research operations such as coordinate the required procedures for clinical trials with the relevant departments and provide other administrative and logistical supports:
- Coordinates the review of Clinical Trial Agreements;
- · Budget preparation and negotiation;
- Being the platform for education, training and information sharing including providing guidance to new investigators and researchers on study design methodology, protocol writing, project management and data management

This development is in line with the National Economic Transformation Programme (ETP), specifically the Health National Key Economic Areas (NKEA) Entry Point Projects on Clinical Research Malaysia. The SunMed CRC will function as part of the national network for clinical research centres (public hospitals, university hospitals, private sector) to meet the targets of increasing the number of clinical trials performed in Malaysia.

Six thousand consumers took part in a brand survey to nominate brands with outstanding performance.


