MEGA PROJECT - SUNWAY VELOCITY'S LATEST PHASE LAUNCHED



RM3.6 billion project continues to transform south of Kuala Lumpur

Spread over 23 acres of prime freehold land, Sunway Velocity is ingeniously integrated with 5 unique elements; VRetail, VOffice, VResidence, VBoulevard and VGarden. The integration of these complementing elements will provide urbanites with a vibrant and sustainable integrated development with well-planned features, catering to today's modern lifestyle. With a total Gross Development Value (GDV) of RM3.6 billion and estimated to be fully completed in year 2018, Sunway Velocity will comprise retail shops; office suites; service apartments, a proposed business hotel, a lifestyle shopping mall and more than 6,500 covered parking bays.

Sunway Velocity's Phase 3C1 consisting 276 units of Designer Offices and 12 units of Retail Shops was officially launched to the public in August. SUNWAY'S LATEST COMMERCIAL PROJECTS WELL-RECEIVED

Sunway Velocity, Sunway Geo and Sunway Wellesley record more than 80% sales

Sunway's recent commercial property offerings over the last quarter, Sunway Velocity's Phase 3C1, Sunway Geo and Sunway Wellesley Phase 1 had recorded more than 80% take-up rate during previews. The total gross development value (GDV) of these projects' phases is approximately RM700 million.



Sunway Geo, a 23.4 acre mixed development, consisting of retail shops, flexi suites, service apartments and condominiums is located next to Sunway Resort City (SRC). The recent preview of Sunway Geo's 31 units of retail shops and 220 units of flexi suites which are priced RM7 million and RM400,000 onwards respectively received overwhelming response and recorded more than 80% take-up rate for the shops.

The success of Sunway Geo can be attributed to its innovative retail concept, accessibility and connectivity as well as enjoying a large catchment pool due to its proximity to SRC with its world renowned amenities. Easier access from SSQ to SRC amenities is available via the free shuttle bus service, pedestrian-friendly walkways and the elevated Canopy Walk. Sunway Geo will also benefit greatly from the proposed elevated Bus Rapid Transit (BRT)-Sunway Line that will run through the township and connect to Setia Jaya KTM and an upcoming LRT station at USJ. The development is also accessible via 6 major highways namely KESAS, LDP, NPE, Federal Highway, NKVE and ELITE, and will soon enjoy access from the elevated connection to NPE and dedicated interchange from KESAS in the future.



Sunway Velocity Phase 3C1 is the latest offering within the freehold 23 acre integrated development, comprising 276 designer offices and 12 units of retail shops, priced from RM537,000 and RM3m respectively.

Located only 3.8km away from Kuala Lumpur City Centre, Sunway Velocity is ingeniously integrated with 5 unique elements; VRetail, VOffice, VResidence, VBoulevard and VGarden. Its lifestyle shopping mall of approximately 1,000,000 sq. ft. will be managed by Sunway's experienced management team.

Sunway Velocity is the only development in the area with two upcoming MRT station (Cochrane and Maluri) and two existing LRT stations (Maluri and Chan Sow Lin) nearby with readily available buses and taxis. The development is bordering Jalan Peel, Jalan Cheras and Jalan Shelly, and is reachable via Jalan Tun Razak, Jalan Loke Yew and Jalan Pudu. It also enjoys excellent linkage to major highways: SMART, KL-Seremban, Maju Expressway, NPE and Besraya Eastern Expansion Project - Maluri and Shamelin Extension.



Another innovative commercial product which received overwhelming response is **Sunway Wellesley Phase 1**, comprising 31 units of three-storey shop office priced from RM972,000. The project with a total acreage of 60 acres is Sunway's latest expansion in Penang.

Sunway Wellesley is conveniently surrounded by the Jit Sin Independent High School, AEON Seberang Prai City Shopping Centres, KPJ Penang Specialist Hospital and the Bukit Mertajam High School. It also enjoys excellent accessibility to North-South Highway, Butterworth-Kulim Expressway and the Penang Bridge and is located strategically within half a kilometer from the Bukit Mertajam Town Centre, 6 km from the Butterworth-Kulim Expressway, 7 km from the North-South Highway, and 9 km to Penang Bridge.



Sunway Berhad's construction arm, Sunway Construction, currently has an order book of over RM4 billion, a record achievement for the construction firm.

Last year, Sunway Construction had secured projects amounting to RM2.06 billion, as well as projects amounting to RM1.239 billion this year.

The first major contract for 2011, was for the construction of Legoland Malaysia Theme Park in Iskandar Malaysia, totaling RM258 million. This was Sunway Construction's first major construction in Iskandar Malaysia. The project was completed and handed over in 31 July 2012.

The second major project for Sunway Construction last year was an order for RM569 million from Syarikat Prasarana Negara Berhad for the construction and completion of facilities works of Package B of the Kelana Jaya Line Extension. The Kelana Jaya Line Extension consists of the construction and completion of facilities along an 8.1 km route from Persiaran Kewajipan, Subang Jaya to Putra Heights. The project commenced in August 2011 and is expected to be completed in 29 months.



The third win in the year was an RM308.9 million contract from Iskandar Malaysia Studios Sdn Bhd to build an integrated media studios facility in Pulau, Johor. In addition to the major wins last year, Sunway Construction had bolstered its order book substantially with the award of an RM1.17 billion contract from Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd for part of the proposed Sungai Buloh Kajang MRT line. The package involves the construction and completion of viaduct guideway from Section 17 in Petaling Jaya to the Semantan portal.

In January, the construction arm had also accepted a letter of award for a contract amounting to RM42.38 million from Tropicana Golf & Country Resort Berhad for the proposed development of 1 block of 16-storey office a block of 38-storey service apartment on 4-storey business premises and 4-storey car park podium in Persiaran Tropicana. The project is targeted to be fully completed on or by 16 January 2013.

Ongoing projects for Sunway Construction are phase two of Impiana KLCC with a contract sum of RM88.0 million, a proposed mixed development in Kuala Lumpur consisting of shop offices, service apartments, and facilities with a contract sum of RM209.6 million, UTM Mara's Zone 1, Phase 2, worth RM191.4 million, Sunway Pinnacle (RM175.1 million), and Wak Hassan Place in Sembawang, Singapore (RM36.11 million) as well as works for Biotechnological Park Bio-Xcell in Nusajaya, Johor Darul Takzim for Malaysia Bio-Xcell Sdn Bhd worth RM74.1 million.

SUNWAY GROUP AND NATIONAL KIDNEY FOUNDATION LAUNCH 2ND MOBILE HEALTH SCREENING UNIT

Providing accessible healthcare to the Malaysian public



Sunway Group and the National Kidney Foundation (NKF) launched the second National Kidney Foundation LifeCheck Mobile Health Screening Unit (NKF LifeCheck), a bus designed specifically to carry out health screenings in Malaysia. This is the second NKF LifeCheck for the NKF and its co-sponsor, Sunway. The first NKF LifeCheck that was launched back in January 2008 has been very successful in reaching out to the public, especially within rural areas throughout Malaysia. To date, the bus has managed to reach out to close to 150,000 people nationwide.

The NKF LifeCheck is a customised 40-seater bus that provides a mobile platform for basic health screenings as well as those focused on the early detection and prevention of kidney-related diseases. Funding for the vehicle stems from a collaborative effort between Sunway and the NKF where RM877,380 was raised during NKF's 40th Anniversary Charity Dinner. Among some of the unique features that the NKF LifeCheck has are seven work stations within the vehicle that are designed for various tests including blood pressure, Body Mass Index, and health counseling.

In line with the Ministry of Health's aim to increase the accessibility of health facilities and screenings to the public, the NKF LifeCheck also serves as an educational tool, screening vital educational health messages via video on board the mobile unit. A service available to Malaysians from all walks of life, the mobile unit provides an avenue for Malaysians who would otherwise have no direct access to potentially life-saving information. Sunway and the NKF, with the support of the Government, hope to encourage members of the public to take necessary precautions and actions to regain, restore and maintain their health through healthy lifestyles with the support of the NKF LifeCheck.
