We believe caring for our people is an embedded value within Sunway Group. Over the years, we have continuously strived to provide relevant and appropriate support to our people in various areas including upgrading the working environment, and taking care of their well-being and development.

The need to support working mothers at the workplace was identified several years back and the plan to build a childcare centre was initiated by top management to provide peace of mind to Sunwayians while they are at work.

As the plan progressed, Group Human Resources formed an official working committee to ensure the successful establishment of the centre, and follow through with implementing other initiatives to better attract, retain and develop women in Sunway.

We are pleased to share that the opening of the childcare centre will be in Q4 2013. With quality being our priority, we have appointed R.E.A.L Kids as our operator. In addition to the childcare centre, we have also successfully implemented a dedicated mother's room and designated car parking spaces for expectant ladies. Currently, we are in the process of further improving on our HR policies to include flexible working arrangements, and looking into options for new mothers to extend maternity leave.

According to the World Bank – Malaysian Economic Monitor's November 2012 Report, labour force participation among Malaysian women remains low at 46 per cent as compared to other ASEAN countries like Singapore (60 per cent) and Thailand (70 per cent). Such numbers indicate the nation is suffering a great loss of talents

and skills from women.

As a recent survey conducted by TalentCorp Malaysia and the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) has found, the top three reasons given by Malaysian women for leaving the workforce is firstly, to raise a family, secondly, lack of work-life balance, and thirdly, to care for a family member. Although 93 per cent of female respondents on a career break indicated their willingness to return to work, a staggering 63 per cent acknowledged they faced many difficulties re-entering the workforce.

To us, these studies affirm that Sunway is on the right track to support and sustain women

in the workplace. Besides adding value to employees, the work we are doing also contributes to the growth of the company and nation.

With strong support from the top management, we are committed to making this journey a success.

All essential facilities and amenities within our flagship development, Sunway Resort City (SRC), are within 500m from residential linked walkways and public transport. Walkways are flanked with low shrubs to enhance security while bollards are built to prevent motorcycle access to pedestrians.



A RM10 million, 1.1km guarded and secure elevated covered canopy walk links Sunway Pyramid to Sunway University and Monash University Malaysia.

The elevated Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) — Sunway Line connects SRC to existing MRT stations and two free shuttle buses ply SRC for safe commuting.

Sunway Pyramid is one of the first shopping malls to be equipped with panic buttons.

We have wider sidewalks than other localities or townships, which are purpose-built to enhance safety for pedestrians.





This is a very proud and exciting moment for every Malaysian, as the Jeffrey Cheah Funds pave the way for greater two-way flow of scholars between Harvard University and the institutions under the Sunway Education Group (SEG), most notably Sunway University and Monash University Malaysia, to support and spearhead research, conferences and workshops related to South-East Asia.

Under the Jeffrey Cheah Funds, a one-time lump sum of USD \$5.2 million establishes the Jeffrey Cheah Professorship of South-East Asia Studies and the Jeffrey Cheah Fellowship in South-East Asia Studies, both in perpetuity. It also establishes the Jeffrey Cheah Visiting Professorship of South-East Asia Studies Fund.

The balance of USD \$1 million will go towards funding the Jeffrey Cheah Travel Grants for South-East Asia Studies. Available in annual payments of USD \$100,000 each, the Travel Grant will enable members of the Harvard community, scholars and practitioners from institutions in South-East Asia, including those under the SEG, to travel to and from Harvard and South-East Asia and Malaysia respectively to present lectures and to conduct research.

To complement this landmark development, Sunway University is in the process of establishing the Jeffrey Cheah Institute of South-East Asia Studies. The set-up and terms of reference of the Institute will be determined in close consultation with Harvard University, it is envisaged that the Institute will act as a catalyst to attract the best and brightest to Sunway to further propel SEG to be the education hub of quality and cutting-edge research.

In line with our core tenets - which include community building and enriching lives - we approach CR through championing three key areas of focus namely Education, Healthcare and C.A.R.E. projects, an acronym for community aid, reach-out and enrichment.

As we expand our presence worldwide, we remain steadfastly committed that CR should always form an integral part of our business framework. By aligning our CR efforts with our business interests, and strengthening the sustainability of our businesses, we aim to create a positive and far-reaching impact on the nation and humankind.



EDUCATION

To the public at large, Sunway may be best known as one of Malaysia's largest

property-construction groups. Instead of building just properties, we believe in building for communities.

"I like to see young minds being educated. Education brings out the best in young people. be executed. That is why I am so passionate in giving to society through education", an inspiring quote by Tan Sri Dr Jeffrey Cheah, Ao, Founder and Chairman of Sunway Group, best exemplifies our commitment to responsible business practices and how we seek to put CR at the heart of our business

The opening of Sunway College in 1987 marks our first important step in championing quality and affordable higher learning for the community and country. The upgrade of Sunway College to University College in 2004 and later to University status in January 2011, the successful partnership with Monash University Australia to set up Monash University Malaysia and most recently, the establishment of the Jeffrey Cheah Professorships at Harvard University (see full story on page 10 & 11), are some of the many examples demonstrating our unflindhing commitment towards this end, not just for 'now' but for the future.

Jeffrey Cheah Foundation (JCF), a not-for-profit entity officially launched in March 2010, is the most definite and visible crystallisation of our Founder's vision and dream to leave a legacy that will benefit the posterity. More than RM720 million of assets of the Sunway Education Group were transferred into JCF in perpetuity, with surpluses ploughed back into the institutions for scholarship, research, upgrading of facilities and infrastructure.

As Sunway's largest philanthropic vehicle, JCF has awarded scholarships in excess of RM130 million to over 16,000 students. JCF has also contributed over RM12.5 million to Chinese vernacular and convent schools to enable major restoration and repair works to

Outside JCF, we have the Jeffrey Cheah Distinguished Speakers Series, a free public lecture organised by Sunway University for the community. We also have the Sunway Job Training Programme for Special Students, a programme started in February 2006 and endorsed by the Ministry of Education,



Malaysia. Under the programme, special youth are exposed to real world environment under the guidance of experienced trainers from Sunway Medical Centre, Sunway Pyramid, Sunway University and Sunway Resort Hotel & Spa.

We believe education should not be about dollars and cents, but should be about making a lasting contribution to society. By changing the education landscape through pioneering game-changing developments such as the widely acclaimed joint degree programme in Malaysia, we believe Sunway will continue to play in the many years to come, a key role in contributing to the creation of the nation's human capital.



HEALTHCARE

Our second pillar in CR, healthcare, stems from our strong belief in the importance of raising the healthcare standards in Malaysia

and in helping to cultivate healthy living through informing and educating the community.

We have pledged to make Sunway Resort City a 100% smoke-free township by 2018. We have also, in collaboration with the National Kidney Foundation (NKF) of Malavsia, successfully raised over RM1.65 million for two NKF LifeCheck Mobile Health Screening Units. customised mobile units that provide early detection and prevention of kidney disease. We have also raised more than RM1 million for the Malaysian Liver Foundation. Such partnerships with health organisations are part and parcel of the intangible assets we endeavour to build to make a far-reaching impact.

Closer to home, Sunway Medical Centre is a key driver of "Let's Take 5," a diabetes campaign held annually in November in conjunction with World Diabetes Day to raise awareness on diabetes. Medical Camps are also organised on a regular basis to grant the less fortunate free health check-ups and screenings performed by medical professionals.
